Iteration and Collective Mentality

- repetition and ‘mentality’
 - persuasion & repetition: propaganda & advertising
 - collective mentality: religion, teaching, media
- thick description & thin description (Geertz)
 - dense, meaningful contexts vs scarcity of meaning
- imagined community & collective mentality (Anderson)
 - synchronic (re)production vs diachronic repetition
- cultural effects
 - new content enters collective mentalities through iteration

In Praise of Frequency

claim:

- mundane and repetitive source material offers entry into a collective mentality

aim:

- integrate DH into historical discipline, through
 - teaching + research published on mainstream platforms

need:

1. highly flexible and malleable infrastructure
2. intuitively understandable DH methods ('radical simplicity': word counts, topic modelling, more complicated things like word embeddings...)
3. easy to access serial data + simple visualisations

Counting stuff: two techniques

1. Frequency counts of related words that co-occur in documents
 - e.g. 'victim' (*slachtoffer*) / 'wounded' (*gewond*) / 'dead' (*dode[n]*) + 'accident' (*ongeluk*) / 'disaster' (*ramp*)
 - different frequency counts of (a selection of) words
 1. the mere occurrence (i.e. is the presence of a word in a news item 'true' or 'false'?)
 2. all occurrences
 3. all possible combinations
 - for five words in theory 31 combinations, in practice 26, such as: <victim + accident> or <victim + disaster>



Counting stuff: two techniques

2. Ngrams (1, 2, 3, 4, 5)

- e.g. 4-gram 'Dear Ladies and Gentlemen' (*Geachte dames en heren*)

Visualising frequencies

- Three sets of options for graphs, concerning:
 1. the kind of graph;
 2. the elements in the graph;
 3. the kind of data.

Visualising frequencies

1. Kind of graph

- timeline: points and lines
- options
 - simple markers (i.e. scatter plot)
 - lines connecting markers (i.e. line graph)
 - smoothed line ('locally weighted scatterplot smoothing')
 - polynomial
 - univariate interpolation
 - combination of any or all of these (markers, normal lines, smoothed lines, polynomials, etc)
- all variables underlying the various calculations to be set by the user.



Visualising frequencies

2. Elements in the graph

- colours, font size and appearance of the x and y axes
- grid
- basic timeline: based on month or years
- zoom function: slices from the timeline
- vertical bars highlighting missing parts of dataset
- headings and legends

3. Kind of data

- four options
 - 1. unique occurrences
 - 2. all occurrences of words
 - 3. occurrences of combinations of words
 - 4. occurrences of combinations of words as well as unique occurrences of words (dual-scale graph)



relative frequency (all)




